ENDURES FOREVER**

IN the Bible, it is written that whatever a slave owns belongs to his master. You must remember this. That is why demons claim your diplomas, your car. All the blessings God has reserved for men will be taken away from them by the gods they worship because they are their masters. One is delivered after giving his life to Jesus. Thus, the yoke of bondage is broken. Through spiritual warfare, fasting, and prayer, believers take possession of the things the devil has stolen from them while they were in bondage. If you do not know your spiritual rights, you will die poor. Let no one deceive you. If you sleep and say that God has already defeated the demons, you will die poor.

You must enter into a fierce battle to take hold of what God has given you. Let no one deceive you! God is called the Lord of Hosts. God loves battles. God loves war. If you engage in a battle to claim your inheritance, God will send angels to help you. God loves this kind of battles.

GOSPEL MESSAGE

Psalm 107:1–43 , Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever. Let the redeemed of the Lord tell their story—those he redeemed from the hand of the foe, those he gathered from the lands, from east and west, from north and south. Some wandered in desert wastelands, finding no way to a city where they could settle. They were hungry and thirsty, and their lives ebbed away. Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress. He led them by a straight way to a city where they could settle. Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind, for he satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things. Some sat in darkness, in utter darkness, prisoners suffering in iron chains, because they rebelled against God's commands and despised the plans of the Most High. So he subjected them to bitter labor; they stumbled, and there was no one to help. Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress. He brought them out of darkness, the utter darkness, and broke away their chains. Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind, for he breaks down gates of bronze and cuts through bars of iron. Some became fools through their rebellious ways and suffered affliction because of their iniquities. They loathed all food and drew near the gates of death. Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress. He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave. Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men. Let them sacrifice thank offerings and tell of his works with songs of joy. Others went out on the sea in ships; they were merchants on the mighty waters. They saw the works of the Lord, his wonderful deeds in the deep. For he spoke and stirred up a tempest that lifted high the waves. They mounted up to the heavens and went down to the depths; in their peril their courage melted away. They reeled and staggered like drunken men; they were at their wits' end. Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress. He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed. They were glad when it grew calm, and he guided them to their desired haven. Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men. Let them exalt him in the assembly of the people and praise him in the council of the elders. He turned rivers into a desert, flowing springs into thirsty ground, and fruitful land into a salt waste, because of the wickedness of those who lived there. He turned the desert into pools of water and the

parched ground into flowing springs; there he brought the hungry to live, and they founded a city where they could settle. They sowed fields and planted vineyards that yielded a fruitful harvest; he blessed them, and their numbers greatly increased, and he did not let their herds diminish. Then their numbers decreased, and they were humbled by oppression, calamity and sorrow; he who pours contempt on nobles made them wander in a trackless waste. But he lifted the needy out of their affliction and increased their families like flocks. The upright see and rejoice, but all the wicked shut their mouths. Whoever is wise, let him heed these things and consider the great love of the Lord.

There are many lessons that can be drawn from this passage. God will speak to us, and we will speak to Him as well.

This first part is addressed to the children of God. God calls on His children to praise Him for He is good and His mercy endures forever. The redeemed of the Lord must say so.

Say:

- Oh God, Your mercy endures forever. You who are already delivered, wake up! God says each one must cry out saying: *"Oh, Your mercy endures forever!"*

Say

- Your mercy endures forever! Oh, Your mercy endures forever!

If you want to pray, you must know these truths. The Psalm we are studying has a purpose: God wants people to believe that He is faithful and answers prayers. God wants everyone to know that if anyone cries out to Him, He will never abandon them. In the past, you went in and out of churches, wandering without any shelter, miserable!

They suffered hunger and thirst. You suffered, we all suffered. They cried out to the Lord in their trouble and the Lord delivered them from their distress. In your own trouble you are crying out. You cried out when you were a pagan and tonight, you will cry out like a child in trouble or under attack. He said: *"Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me."*

Tonight is a night of outcries and answered prayers. Some are still wandering. They are not yet saved; they have not received Jesus in their hearts. They are suffering. But God will answer tonight. If you paid for your transportation to come here tonight, you will not regret it. God will tell His angels to let your prayer rise, even if you have backslidden. He will say to His angels: *"Let his prayer rise."*

Verse 10, *"Some sat in darkness, in utter darkness, prisoners suffering in iron chains."*

There is another category of people who are in chains, held captive by satan. Misery is when someone has nothing to eat. You are sitting in darkness, in the shadow of

death, dreaming about death every night. You feel as if a rope is tied around your neck. You are not the first one in that situation. Those people had the same issue, living in chains, like you.

When someone has nothing to eat, or is deeply indebted without a way out - that is captivity. Being in debt or consistently failing is called misery. Where does misery come from? From rebellion against the Word of God. Why does God forbid debt? Because it is against His counsel. Everyone who rebels against God's counsel will fail. School children who cheat at school to succeed are thieves. Even if they get through, the obtained certificate is a fake one. You are miserable. When God says: "Do not cheat," if you obey and go to write your exam, He will give you your true score. Even if you fail, God's hand will be upon you. God always supports children who study.

Why were they miserable? Because they disobeyed God's counsel. Some girls get pregnant during the first term of the school year because they despised the Word of God and wanted to have fun. They end up with a pregnancy of an unwanted child. The father denies paternity, saying: "I'm not responsible." And they falsely attribute the child to someone else. That is miserable and unfortunate. Then, they begin to suffer because they have abandoned the Word of God.

In this case, you may pray, but God does not answer, and things do not change. When you are rebellious towards God, He humiliates you. He brings you down. He makes things difficult for you. I tell you the truth, God's punishment is worse than what the devil can do.

David said: "to the pure you show yourself pure, but to the crooked you show yourself shrewd." God can make you miserable because He is sovereign. He gave the laws by which we are to walk with Him. If you disobey, He humiliates you, He brings you down. God gives you over to demons who begins to maltreat you. Afterwards, the devil can come and destroy you. But when God's hand is on someone, satan can do nothing to them. However, if that person rebels, God abandons him, and he becomes demons' toy.

The first group of people cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and the Lord delivered them. The second group also cried out to the Lord, and He delivered them from their anguish.

Tonight, if you are wise, you will realize that you are suffering because you are far away from God. Cry out to God. He will answer you. God wants us to know that He is very sensitive to the outcries of those who acknowledge their foolishness. When you muddle through, He leaves you.

They cried out to the Lord, and He brought them out of darkness and out of the shadow of death. That is why I often say: God holds no grudges.

Verse 17: "Some became fools through their rebellious ways and suffered affliction because of their iniquities."

The other category of people is the wicked. They quarrel everywhere, drink alcohol, go to bars. They think they are strong, but sin has consequences. They are already sick. they may be given all kinds of food, but they lose weight. They are almost

dead. Some are in the hospital, and you can feel that they are dying.

In their trouble, they understood that the true God helps and saves people. So they said, "Let us cry out - He will have mercy on us." They cried out too. They cried out to the Lord.

What does it mean to "*cry out?*" It means to confess all your sins, saying: "*I am almost dead. Forgive me. Come to my rescue.*" To cry out is to pray in such a way that touches God's heart and makes him forgive and deliver you. When you say to God: "*I am a poor sinner. I messed around and left You. Now I am about to die, and I have no one else.*"

When you cry out, you repent. You call upon Him for help and acknowledge the evil you have done - then He intervenes. You see, since we began, He has been delivering people. He even delivers some before they give up on their sin, even the new souls. In your trouble, you must cry out to God. God keeps repeating the same thing so that it catches your attention.

Why does God want us to say that His mercy endures forever? From the foundation of the world till today, all those who have called upon Him, those who have cried out to Him, have never been abandoned. He says: "Sing, proclaim throughout the earth that God is good and that His mercy endures forever."

Mercy is forgiveness. God has mercy on you and forgives you. The cry is the acknowledgment of your sins. Your cries will rise up to God, it is what is called crying out. The response God sends is mercy.

If you cry out tonight, whatever your situation, if you acknowledge your sins, if you acknowledge your pride, God will act.

God just wants to show them that going to school is not enough, He wants to show them that science is not enough. God wants to show them that pride is not good. God is showing them that those things are not enough. Even if you are a researcher, an inventor, you still need God.

God Almighty masters all situations. Every cry received a response. No one ever cried out and perished. If you cry out to God tonight with real cries, saying: "I renounce my pride. Save me!" He will save you and deliver you.

God tells us here what He is capable of. You can trust Him and must come to Him.

He turns rivers into desert, springs into dry land. He can command and all the trees will wither; the sun will scorch the grass.

He can find your life a wilderness where everything is dry. If He speaks over your life, the rain will fall in that wilderness. God will visit you and put money in your pockets, and the dryness will be over. That is what happened to a sister who was miserable with a debt of twelve million CFA Francs. If Jesus had not intervened, her debt would have reached 50 million. But Jesus is good. She paid everything back. He caused the rain to fall in the wilderness. He takes the hungry and fills them with good things. He will do the same for you, and you will be a part of those who give testimony. You who are homeless, God will provide you with a home, a nation, a household, a family. You will start a family and settle down. You will become the

head of a household, and people will refer to you as the head of the family. You will have a family. God will establish you. And people will say, "This is the work of God, for the one who was once lost is now one of us." People will say: "Jesus is alive and good." He will bless you and You will work, whether in the city or in the village and the work of your hands will be blessed. You will sow and you will reap. With Jesus, everything is new. He said in His Word: *"I am about to do new things on earth"* You are one of the people God will touch. The new things he is about to do will change your life. He will bless you if you are able to get rid of your evil heart and cry out to God. He will bless you.

A sister testified that she was a witch and her children abandoned her, but God delivered her, and her children forgave her. You will become a family like that of Abraham. If you want children but your uterus has been removed, do not say: *"Lord, I do not have a uterus."* Instead, say to God: *"I want a child."* Death will not dwell in your home.

He lifts the needy out of their affliction. God wants us to believe this.

Say:

-  Lord, I knew, but I did not pray as I should.

God will even heal spiritual barrenness. He will give you true spiritual children who will help you in life.

Sin shuts your mouth. When you live in sin, your mouth is shut over small or big sins.

Let us rise on our feet:

You can bring your family into glory!

Say:

- Lord, your mercy endures forever and I believe it is true. Your mercy endures forever! (Keep asking Him for forgiveness, like a child asking for forgiveness from their father.)

Say:

- Lord, you are good, and your mercy endures forever! (Keep speaking to Him!)

Say:

- Lord, forgive us and deliver us from the consequences of our sins, from the consequences of our rebellion, from the consequences of our pride! We thought we were strong, but you have shown us that we are nothing. Begin to ask for forgiveness. Carry your family in your heart. Ask God to take away its illnesses and misery.

You are in God's presence. You know yourself. You know your family. You know your illnesses. You know your hardships. You know your pride. Ask God to deliver those who thought they were intelligent, graduates who have ended up among the last. You are in debt. You are sick. You are weak. You may be handsome, yet every woman rejects you. You may be beautiful, but no one notices you, even when you wear makeup to attract attention, no one looks at you.

Cry out to God saying:

- Look at the disease, cancers, and goiters, deliver us! Look at the dryness—make us fruitful! Cry out to God now and say to Him: *“Speak to us!”*

Listen, the Lord wants us to speak with one voice. He has listened, but He says He wants us to have one voice. Forget your own family. Let everyone say: *“Lord, deliver us!”* Let it be one common cry—not individual cries. Then He will act. One united cry.

Make your family my family, and so on. When one person is answered, everyone is answered.

Say:

- Oh Father, forgive us! Deliver my family from misery! It is written: ‘They cried out to the Lord and he delivered them.’ (Let us pray to God together. Let us pray in tongues.)

Pray with faith—He is good and His mercy endures forever. (Let us pray together!)

Say:

- Oh Father, look at these illnesses, command healing! Look at these infirmities—command deliverance! Look at the demonic oppressions command deliverance! Act! (Keep praying.)
- Oh Father, in your holy name, may the chains of captivity be broken! May the bonds of captivity be shattered! May illnesses be defeated!
- In the name of Jesus Christ, let the yoke of the oppressor be judged! Let the weapons of the wicked be broken! Let the words of the wicked be nullified!
- Lord, let your work prosper in our lives! Let your purposes be fulfilled in our lives! (Continue to pray.)

Say:

- Oh Father, answer us!
- Fight for us in the deserts! Fight for us in the heavenly realms! Fight for us in the abyss! Fight for us on the mountains! Fight for us at the roots of the mountains! Fight for us at the roots of the trees! Fight for us in the treetops! Fight for us in the sacred forests! Fight for us in hades! Fight for us in fetish huts! Fight for us in fetish chambers! Fight for us in the houses of skulls! Fight for us against snakes! Let everything that harbours demons be destroyed and uprooted! Fight for us, in the name of Jesus Christ!
- Oh Father, raise your sword against the enemy’s camp! Command life where death was expected! (Continue to pray.)

Say:

- In the name of Jesus, if there is among us a brother or a sister who has been fighting the battle alone and the enemy has resisted so far, we now come to the rescue of this brother or sister. We raise our hands to break the yoke of their adversaries! We break their support of pride! We break their resistance! We scatter the adversaries! We scatter the enemies! We break their tongues! We

disorganize them! We destroy everything they relied on! We uproot what they planted!" (Continue to pray.)

- In the name of Jesus, we scatter the enemies who live among human beings! We cast out those who have stood in our way! We remove them from the path of every brother! Every human being who has sworn that we will never see happiness and victory, we drive them away from our path! (Continue to pray. Pray with strength so that you may have victory.)

Say:

- In the name of Jesus Christ, we pray against every professional or spiritual roadblock—whatever is called a roadblock on a brother's path. We destroy it! We clear the way! We remove the obstacles and open the way!

Say:

- In the name of Jesus, if a brother has submitted an application that has been locked up, we unlock that application! If it has been hidden under the table, we bring it out! If it has been buried in a grave, we take it out of the grave! If it has been locked up in a drawer, we take it out!
- We take away all academic obstacles! We release PhD theses, the dissertations, all academic documents—we release everything! Even at the professional level we release promotions!
- All obstacles in the pathway of victorious walking in Christ, we remove them and clear the way! (Continue to pray.)
- We release true marriages! We remove the obstacles! We judge the hindrances on the path to marriage! (Continue to pray.)

You may have your seat. While you are calm, present your misery to God.

Say:

- Lord, look at the work of the enemies! Lord, deliver me!

You must go back home free today! Free! Let your enemies be under your feet! Let your enemy be under your feet! Under your feet! Enemies, we declare: "Under the feet!" We break your resistance! Your place is under the feet. God Himself has ordained it! He said: "If anyone does attack you, it will not be my doing; whoever attacks you will surrender to you." You will go back home free with your enemy under your feet!

Say:

- I proclaim that my enemy's place is under my control! I proclaim that the situation has turned around! I now have dominion, not the enemy! Not the snake! Not the spirit of the dead! I declare that it is written: *'If anyone does attack me will surrender to you!'* (Pray for this to come to pass.)
- Let them be destroyed and broken!
- God is not a plotter, conspiracy comes from the enemy! And the enemy's place is under our feet! Now rise up and rule over him! Go away—leave my life!
- In the name of Jesus, I take back everything you have stolen! Go away! My enemy—let the Word be fulfilled against you! Go away—leave my life! Leave my path! Leave my plans! Leave my household! Leave my children! Leave my

husband! Leave my wife! Leave my car! Leave my house! Go away—exit in the name of Jesus Christ! (Let us pray in tongues.)

Keep calm.

- Satan, your place is under my feet! God has judged you! The Lord has judged you! He will not change! That will not change! Your place is under the feet, crushed! Destroyed! You are poor! You take nothing because you have nothing! Souls belong to Jesus!
- Jesus said: *“And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.”* Jesus loves us and we must serve Him. You satan, have no business in it. We judge the witchcraft you use for your reign! We disorganize your troops! We set the captives free! We sabotage demons’ agendas and everything they have planned against living human beings! We rend their pacts and covenants! Accidents, fires will not happen! Your yoke is broken! The plot is destroyed! The Church’s projects will prosper! The plans of God’s children will prosper! Everything concerning the Lord’s purposes for His people will prosper!
- If you feel pain somewhere, put your hand on that part: “Sickness, you are judged! Sickness, you are one my enemies—I judge you! I cast you out of my body!
- We judge any sickness caused by demons, sickness caused by any organ dysfunction, whether you are caused by demons or organ dysfunction, you are a sickness, get out! Leave my body! exit in the name of Jesus! Get lost!
- In the name of Jesus, Let everything the sorcerers have swallowed up be vomited! Let everything they have devoured be vomited! Let everything that has been swallowed up be expelled! It is the Lord who is expelling all out of your belly! It is God’s judgment! Everything swallowed up, even if a person’s soul has been swallowed up by a sorcerer with a aim of gaining power while the other one is suffering, you are judged. get out!
- Every spirit or sorcerer who has swallowed up someone’s soul to increase their own power while the other person suffers, we strike you! And we command that the victim be set free—let the person live! Let your power come to an end! Let the person live! Let your power be destroyed! Let your power be banished! Let the person’s soul come out victorious!
- You have heard people saying that they saw their parents coming out of them. We are going to cast out any spirit that has incarnated someone. You are here with evil thought, you do not know where it is coming from, but a sorcerer is living inside you. Any spirit that has possess someone and that person is having challenges, we chase you away, it is not your body, it is the body of Jesus, in the name of Jesus, get out!
- If you are a serpentine spirit that has took possession of a man or a woman—like the python that had possessed the girl in Acts 16:16, get out! You python spirit—exit now!

If your parents worshipped snakes, you must deal with the issue seriously. In Acts 16:16, a python was living inside of a young girl, and giving her revelations—until

Paul cast it out. If your parents worshipped snakes, while we pray, strike mercilessly hard. There are serpentine spirits living inside human beings. There are spirits of the dead dwelling in people causing them to feel heavy. They get angry like wild animals. This is caused by the serpentine spirit, crocodiles spirit, gorillas spirit, idols that were worshipped. So, as the crusade go on—continue in true repentance, uproot the idols, and baobab trees will fall.

Say:

- I cast out every presence! Every spirit living in me. I cast you out! Get out and go away!
- I declare that I belong to Jesus! I want no spirit of the dead! I want no serpentine spirit! Leave, in the name of Jesus! Even if I invited you myself, Jesus has revealed to me that is wrong. Get out! I have already accepted Jesus, leave now ! I do not need you! I have given everything to Jesus—leave! I have consecrated everything to Jesus—leave! Get out!
- In the name of Jesus, I take back everything belonging to me that you have stolen. No one steals that which is mine! I hide everything that I own in the blood of Jesus!
